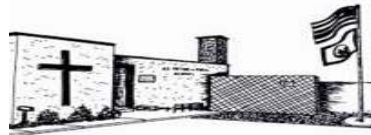


SCHOOL NEWS.... School Begins August 13th

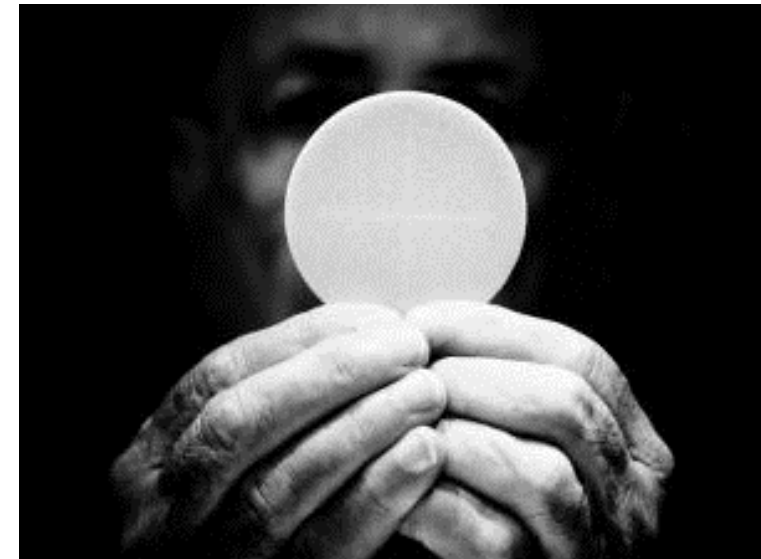
