Reflection on the Second Sunday of Easter ~ Divine Mercy Sunday

Divine Mercy:

Divine Mercy is the offer of Jesus Christy, the God Man, giving us His forgiveness and compassion, especially thru the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It is a devotion promulgated by the late great Pope, St. John Paul II - thru the private revelations of Saint Faustina Kawalski, a polish nun. It is a call to forgiveness. Confession, to God's ever flowing Mercy which is a "font of blood and water" ready to wash clean of sin and evil. It is an appeal to both God and each soul for reconciliation re-connecting what has been broken by sin and evil actions and thoughts.

Why do we need Divine Mercy? - abortions, drug culture, loss of catholic culture and identity in our schools, churches and nations. The loss of God and prayer in our public life - violence.

But, all can make a spiritual rebound like St. Augustine, Mary Magdalene, Bernard Nathanson (who aborted over 60,000 babies) - he repented and became Catholic..
