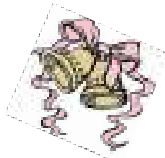

Reflection on the Fourth Sunday of Easter - Cycle C

May 7 - 8, 2022

“My sheep hear my voice; I know them and they follow me.” Jn. 10:28

Jesus is our Good Shepherd. He left the paradise of heaven to seek out and save. Us who are lost sheep, who have mired ourselves in sin. The entire season of Easter is about celebrating Christ’s victory over sin and death.

The Fourth Sunday of Easter is traditionally called, “Good Shepherd Sunday.” We Christians, although justified through the Sacrament of Baptism, continue throughout our lives to stray from God. We need the Good Shepherd each day.

There is this tender intimacy that the Shepherd has for, and wants - for His flock. This is a closeness that we don’t deserve, but which the Good Shepherd desires for His flock. He will give up His life for His sheep.

May is the MONTH OF OUR BLESSED MOTHER
and celebrating Motherhood

A) May is traditionally dedicated in a special way to honoring and seeking the intercession of Mary as the Mother of God and Mother of the Church.

It is also on the month of May that the Church remembers the major apparition of Our Blessed Mother to the three young children from Portugal – as Our Lady of Fatima. On these occasions, our Blessed Mother has predicted major events that have occurred. Her feast day of Our Lady of Fatima is on May 13 – the first apparition – until the last on October 13.

“She is that woman who rejoiced in the presence of God, who treasured everything in her heart - and who let herself be pierced by the sword. Mary is the Saint among all Saints - Blessed above all others. She teaches the way of holiness and she walks ever at our side. She does not let us remain fallen And at times, she takes us into her arms without judging us.”

~ Pope Francis, Gaudete et Exultate, no. 176.

B) May is also dedicated to mothers, grandmothers, stepmothers, mothers to be – and all women who in and through their lives encompass the qualities of motherhood.
