Reflection—Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Times

“A new teaching with authority” Mark 1: 21 - 28

Seven points in which Christ taught with authority (Fr. Cornelius Lapide)

- A) Jesus taught important matters of the highest importance which are necessary for salvation. The scribe taught trifling matters of rites and ceremonies.
- B) What Jesus taught in word, fulfilled in deed and action. Because He is without sin, our Lord teaches with the greatest authority.
- C) Jesus taught with great spirit and fervor, such that the words of Scripture could always be applied to Him.
- D) Jesus confirmed His teachings by miracle, which the scribes could not do.
- E) The scribe were mere interpreters of the law, but Jesus us The Lawgiver part from heaven.
- F) Jesus taught solely for the Glory of God - the scribe sought their own glory.
- G) Jesus illuminated the minds and inflamed the hearts of His hearers. He made the ignorant become learned, and the wicked to become good.
