**DESSERTS NEEDED !!!**

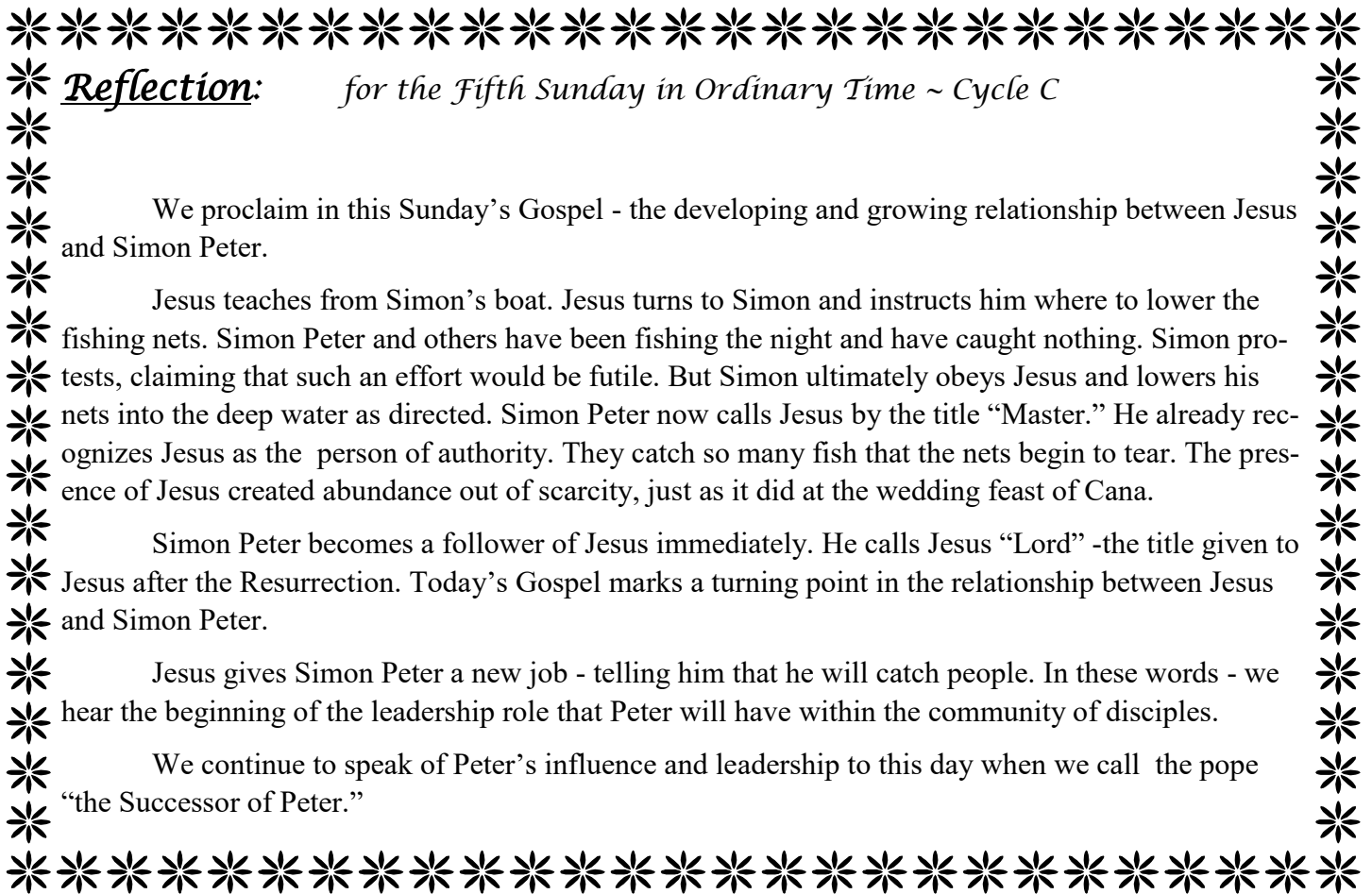

**Reflection:**      *for the Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time ~ Cycle C*

We proclaim in this Sunday’s Gospel - the developing and growing relationship between Jesus and Simon Peter.

Jesus teaches from Simon’s boat. Jesus turns to Simon and instructs him where to lower the fishing nets. Simon Peter and others have been fishing the night and have caught nothing. Simon protests, claiming that such an effort would be futile. But Simon ultimately obeys Jesus and lowers his nets into the deep water as directed. Simon Peter now calls Jesus by the title “Master.” He already recognizes Jesus as the person of authority. They catch so many fish that the nets begin to tear. The presence of Jesus created abundance out of scarcity, just as it did at the wedding feast of Cana.

Simon Peter becomes a follower of Jesus immediately. He calls Jesus “Lord” -the title given to Jesus after the Resurrection. Today’s Gospel marks a turning point in the relationship between Jesus and Simon Peter.

Jesus gives Simon Peter a new job - telling him that he will catch people. In these words - we hear the beginning of the leadership role that Peter will have within the community of disciples.

We continue to speak of Peter’s influence and leadership to this day when we call the pope “the Successor of Peter.”

## Our Catholic Faith:

### February 11, 2022 - Our Lady of Lourdes

### ~ World Day of the Sick

Each year on February 11 (the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes) -the World Day of the Sick is celebrated - and was established by Pope John Paul II on February 11, 1992.

This day commemorates Our Lady of Lourdes with visions to St. Bernadette Soubirous in France which began on February 11, 1889. The healing waters of Lourdes which St. Bernadette dug through the instructions of our Blessed Mother continue to provide healing to those who bathe in the water.

The World Day of the Sick was inaugurated on February 11, 1993 - and was referred only to those who were physically ill - but Pope St. John Paul II enlarged this scope 3 years later to include those who are suffering with emotionally, spiritually, psychologically symptoms.

Pope Francis, this year, released a message on this World Day of the Sick 2022 - in it - he says not to forget those suffering from illness in quarantine and isolation due to the pandemic - and commends the work of health care workers tending to the ill during the pandemic, who he says offers signs of compassion to those in difficulty.
