Our Catholic Faith:

**The Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation**  
~ The going back to God's grace.

Sin is before all else an offense against God, a rupture of communion with Him. At the same time, it damages communion with the Church. For this reason, conversion entails both God's forgiveness and reconciliation with the Church, which are expressed and accomplished liturgically by the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation. [CC 1440].

Christ willed that in her prayer and life and action His whole Church should be the sign and instrument of the forgiveness and reconciliation that He acquired for us by the price of His Blood. But He entrusted the exercise and power of absolution to the apostolic ministry which He charged with the ministry of reconciliation." [2 Cor. 5: 18]

Earlier this year, Pope Francis announced a world-wide Synod to focus on the life and mission of the Church as we move forward together. The theme of this Synod is "For A Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission." Rather than simply a meeting of Bishops, Pope Francis has asked us, the people of God, to take part in the Synod; to "Journey together, with our brothers and sisters in Christ" along the path of renewal, guided by the Holy Spirit. The Holy Father has asked that every parish in the Diocese participate in this Synod in order to listen to the Living Voice of the entire People of God. The parish of Sts. Peter & Paul will conduct a synodal listening session on Saturday, April 9, 2022, at 10:00a.m. in the parish hall. This session will provide an opportunity for every member of the parish community to share their thoughts and feeling, but more importantly, to discern how the Holy Spirit is guiding us in our journey together.
