Peter & Paul hopes to launch the Catholic Sharing Appeal 2021 on June 13/14, 2021 - in all Masses on the Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time, with a brief introduction before the final dismissal. Some of our parish families have donated through the Diocese letter. Many thanks to these families. If we reach our goal of \$16,965 for this year, Sts. Peter & Paul will retain 50% of the funds and the parish hopes to use this refund for the improvements of the parish church, our pre-k facilities (which are hoping to expand), and some bonuses for our teachers who have really given a lot of their love for our children. There were no salary increases for this year due to the Covid issue.
- (2) Our Give Love Campaign is being monitored strictly by our finance council. We will be reporting expenses from these funds as they come.
