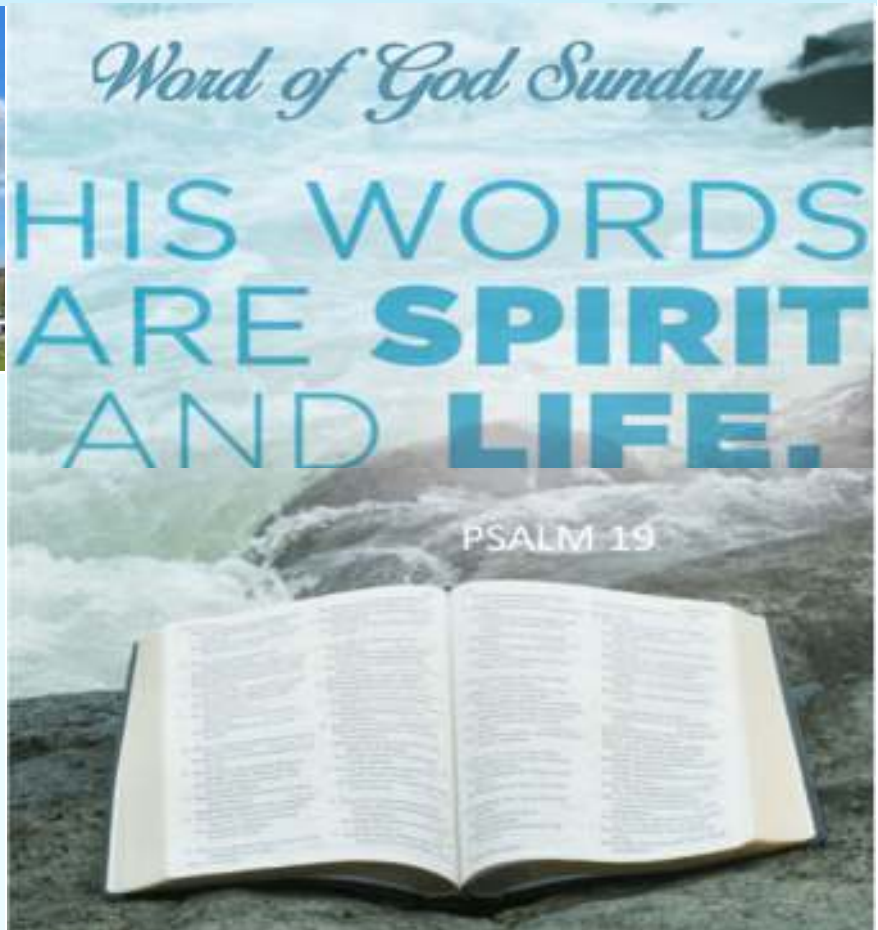

We need to raise \$17,850.00 to complete this multi-purpose playground. We request prayer and consideration for this purpose. Your end-of-year donations will make a difference!

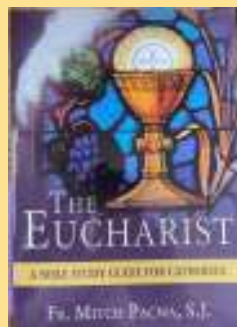
