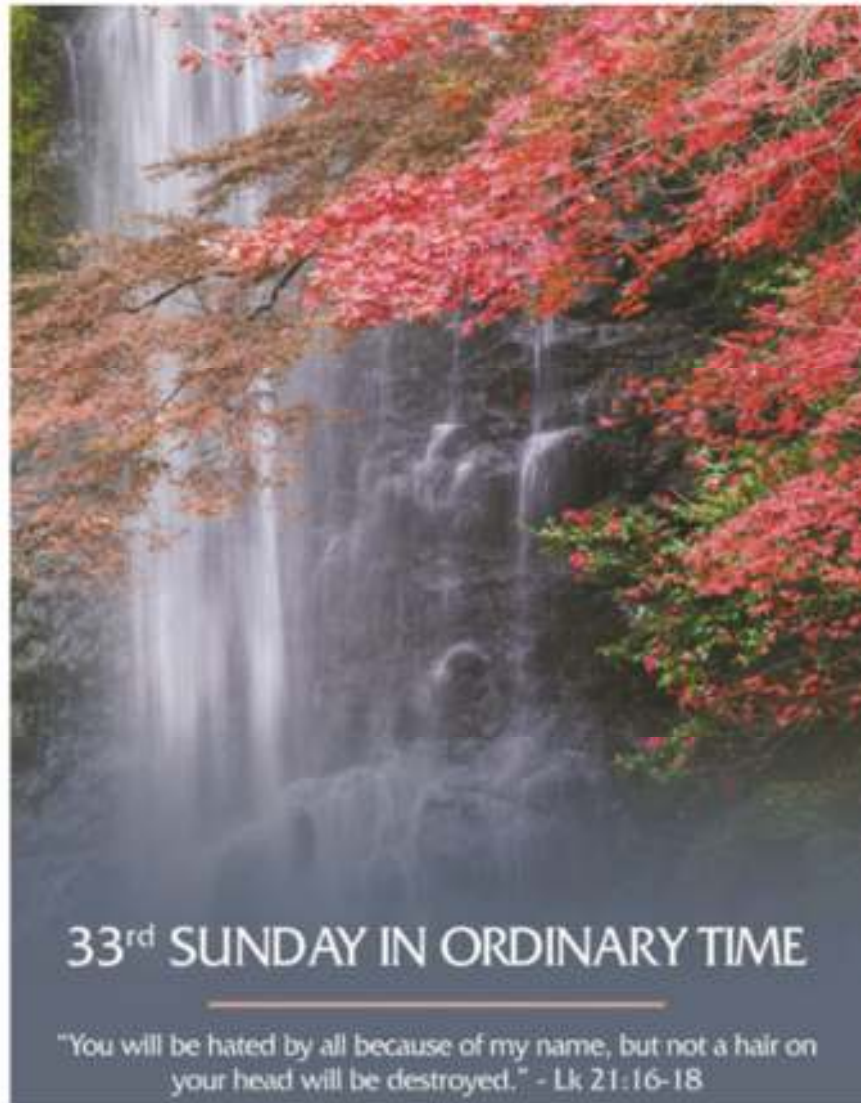

Tour of Relics

On Wednesday, November 16, the Beckley Vicariate will be blessed by the visit of relics of Blessed Carlo Acutis and St. Manuel Gonzalez. Bl. Carlo Acutis was a teenager who had a great devotion to Our Lord's Real Presence in the Eucharist, and he shared that love with others, especially through his skilled use of the internet. He died of leukemia at the age of 15. St. Manuel Gonzalez, who was a bishop in Spain, also had a great love for the Eucharist, and promoted frequent Holy Communion and Eucharistic Adoration. Their relics are touring throughout the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston as part of our observance of the Eucharistic Revival.

The relics will arrive at St. Francis de Sales Parish, 614 S. Oakwood Ave., Beckley at 11:00 a.m.

A special Mass will be celebrated at 12:00 noon with the St. Francis de Sales Parish and School communities, followed by Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament throughout the afternoon until Benediction at 6:00 p.m. A second Mass will be celebrated at 6:30 p.m.

An opportunity to venerate the relics will be provided at the conclusion of both Masses and during the time of adoration as well. All priests and parishes of the Beckley Vicariate are welcome and encouraged to join together for any and all of these observances.
