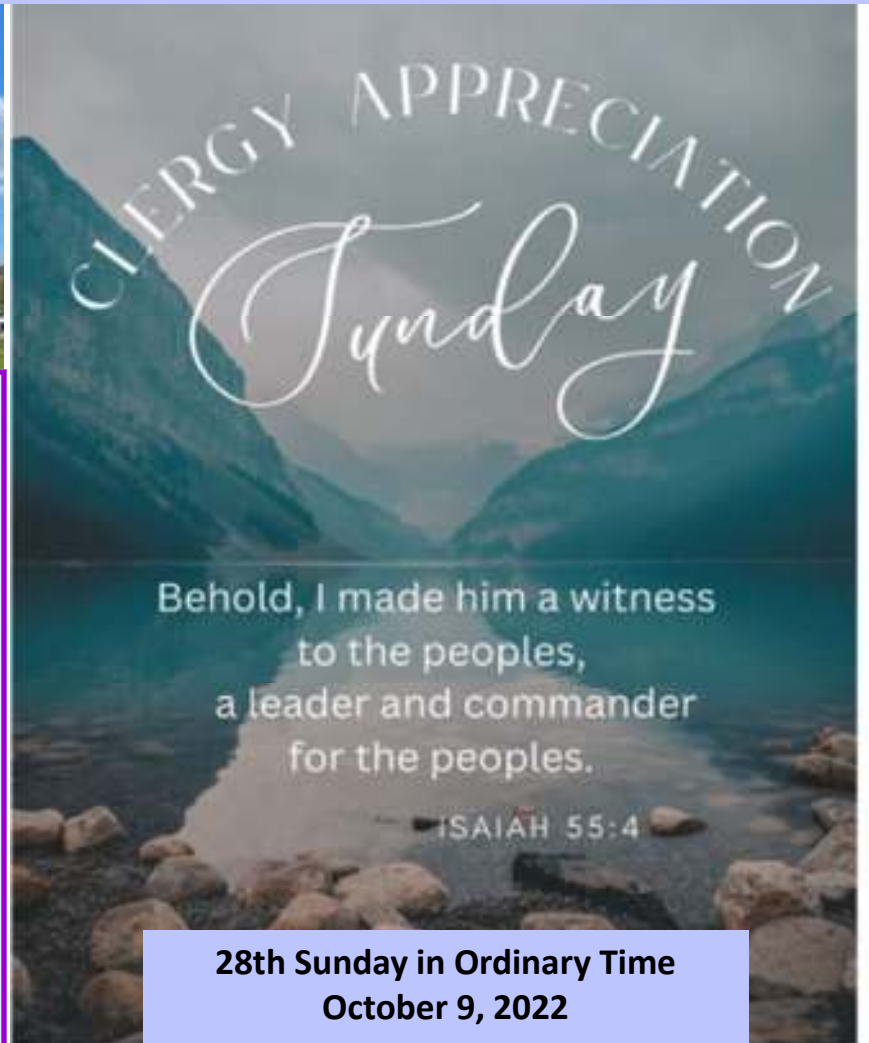

USCCB's National Eucharistic Revival is to revive and reinvigorate belief in Christ's true presence in the Eucharist.

The Eucharistic Revival began with widespread eucharistic processions and adoration on the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ in June 19, 2022. The Eucharistic Revival is a Spirit-led renewal

of the Church in the United States from the inside out—not a top-down program.

The National Eucharistic Revival has four significant components:

1. Year of Diocesan Revival – June 19, 2022 until June 11, 2023 - diocesan events for the faithful centered around Christ's true presence in the Eucharist. The theme for the diocesan year of the Eucharistic Revival in the Diocese of Wheeling Charleston is "My Flesh for the Life of the World" from John 6:51.
2. Year of Parish Revival - June 11, 2023, to July 17, 2024 – parishes coordinate local events for deeper encounters with Christ through Adoration, Mass, enrichment, group studies, etc.
3. National Eucharistic Congress Event - July 17-21, 2024 – Catholics of all ages will gather in Indianapolis for a five-day conference to build enthusiasm among the faithful to be "Eucharistic missionaries."
4. National Year of Mission - July 17, 2024, to Pentecost 2025 – all Catholics are encouraged to evangelize and be a light of Christ in the world.

Remember, revival starts with you and it's for our spiritual benefit. The most important aspect of this Revival will happen in your own heart. Learn what Christ has revealed about this precious gift and why it is pivotal to your spiritual journey. Each individual, parish, and diocese to respond in their own way.

What are your suggestions to our parish level Eucharistic revival? Please let your pastor or pastor council know.
