

Second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Jesus transforms water into wine.

Today we begin a stretch of Ordinary Time that will last about a month. Some have called this segment of Ordinary Time a "season of discipleship," because the Gospel readings cover the early ministry of Jesus and the calling of the first disciples. On this day we will see Jesus at the wedding at Cana, traditionally the third manifestation of Christ, following Christmas and Epiphany. Perhaps our prayer today can be that we be able to see Jesus as well, in others whom we meet every day.
