We were busy before Christmas Break with “all things Christmas” from ornaments to cards. Each class made an ornament for the tree, then took their ornaments home after the break.

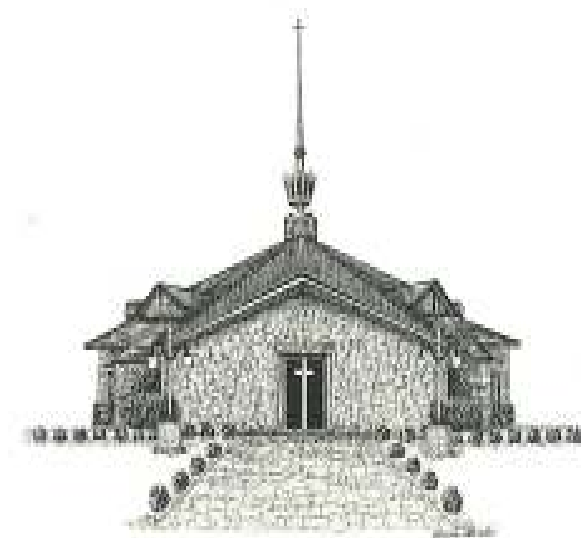
