

Lenten Fasting & Abstinence

Fasting is to be observed on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday by everyone 18 years and older who has not yet celebrated their 59th birthday.

On a fasting day, one full meal is allowed. Two other meals, may be taken, but together they should not equal another full meal.

Eating between meals is not permitted, but consuming liquids, including milk and juices, is allowed.

Abstinence is observed by everyone 14 years of age or older.

On days of abstinence, no meat is allowed.

Ash Wednesday, all the Fridays during Lent, and Good Friday are days of abstinence.

If a person is unable to observe the above regulations due to ill health or other serious reasons, other suitable forms of self denial are encouraged.
