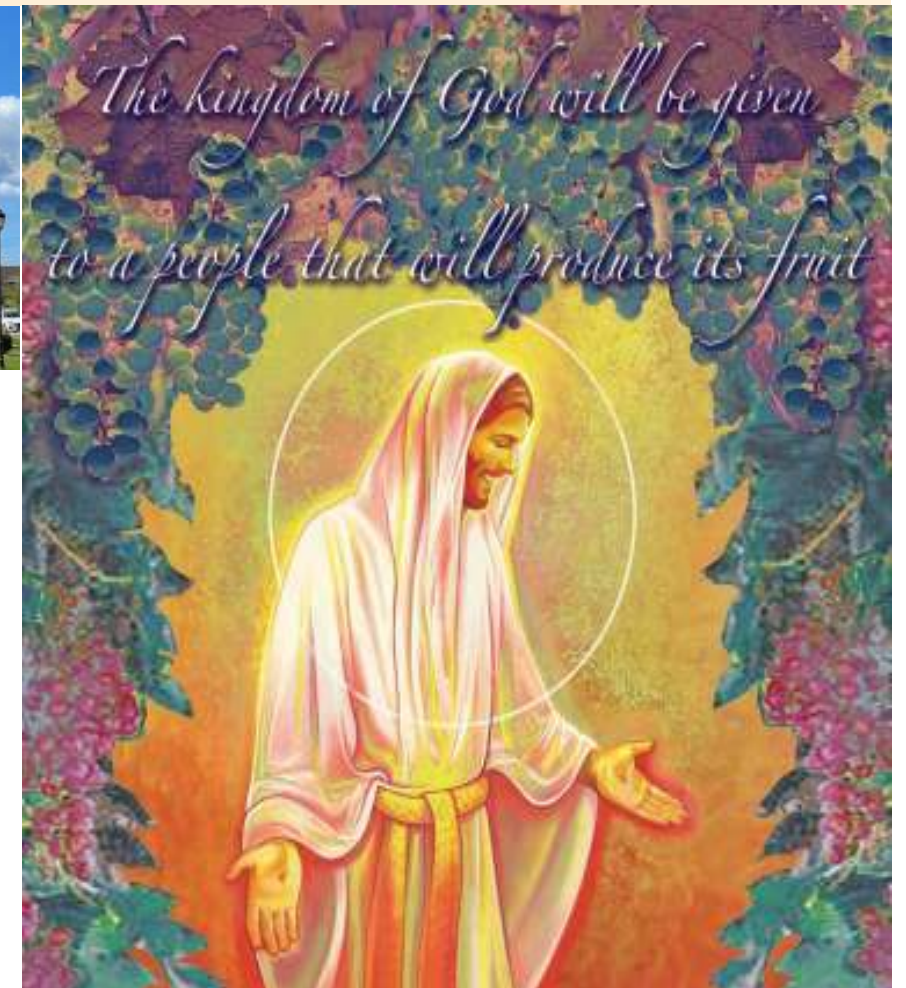
School News
