

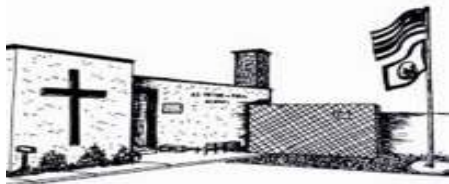
SCHOOL NEWS....Natasha Seay, ELA Teacher
