In addition to preaching on behalf of Food For the Poor for over 13 years, he is the Associate Professor of Religious Studies at Edgewood College in Madison, WI where he also teaches courses in Catholicism, World Religions, Medical Ethics & Ecclesiology. Fr. Scott travels extensively around the world to study different religions. He has written 2 books, the latest being "Beyond Agreement" which is about how to have a productive interreligious dialogue even when both sides may never come to agreement.
