Our New Blessed

(1) Blessed Carlos Acutis: Monza, Italy

Cyber Apostle of the Most Holy Eucharist
Patron Saint of the Internet

A young adult/teenager who spread the Catholic Faith and the devotion to the Most Holy Eucharist by computer Born in London on May 3, 1991, to a wealthy Italian family and died on October 12, 2006, in Monza, Italy due to leukemia. Blessed Carlos was buried in Assisi. He became a frequent communicant & devoted to the Most Holy Eucharist after his First Communion at the age of 7. Blessed Carlo catalogued in his website all the Eucharistic miracles of the world—and stated on his website: “the more Eucharist we receive, the more we become like Jesus, so that on this earth, we may have a foretaste of heaven.”

(2) (Blessed) Michael Joseph McGivney:

An American Priest based in New Haven, Connecticut. He founded the Knights of Columbus at a local parish to serve as a mutual aid & fraternal insurance organization, particularly for immigrants and their families. It developed through the 20th century as the world's largest catholic fraternal organization. As of 2020, this organization has 28 million member families and 15,000 councils. Born of an Irish immigrant family, he was the eldest of 13 children. Pope Francis announced that the Venerable Father Michael Joseph McGivney will be beatified on October 31, 2020.
