**Saints Peter & Paul Catholic School Awarded
The McDonald's Balanced, Active Lifestyle Academic Awards Grant**

Southern West Virginia and southwest Virginia McDonald's owners/operators recently awarded Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic School with one of five \$500 grants for use on a program designed for 5th - 8th grade students for the purpose of development of an academic program to promote a balanced, active lifestyle. Entries from the two states were judged based upon creativity, educational content, and program cost effectiveness.

Sts. Peter and Paul designed a program designed to motivate students to develop a more active, healthy lifestyle while teaching them how the body uses/burns calories, proper use of a pedometer to accurately track their physical activity, to accurately keep an activity and food diary, to correctly use calorie burn equation to accurately calculate their calories burned, and to motivate them to develop an effective activity plan to follow after the program is finished.

The program will encompass three classes and three instructors, Health, Math, and Science. Our Health instructor will teach students how to create and keep an effective activity log & a food journal sufficient to promote a healthier lifestyle, using videos, on-line components, & other programs for instruction. Our Science instructor will use models to show the effect that activity and sedentary lifestyles can have on the human body, body's use of calories, and calorie body burn procedures, along with instruction, videos and projects to increase and promote understanding of the importance of adopting healthy, active habits through using/reading food labels, food pyramid, and My Plate activities. Finally, our Math instructor will teach students formulas on calculating steps to find calorie burn with the formula using simple math to teach calculation of calorie burn vs calorie intake.
