Father Benedict Edward Kapa, 67, of Bridgeport, passed away January 26th. He was born on Jan. 1, 1953, in Philadelphia, PA. He was preceded in death by his parents Benedict J. and Helen (Kugiel) Kapa; and brother, Stanley F. Kapa.
