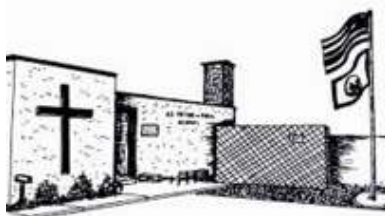

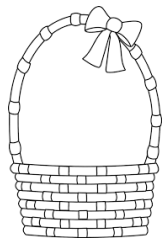
Easter Sunday 2nd Collection
