Holy Land Pilgrimage – January 14-24, 2020

We will renew our baptismal promises at the Jordan River, renew wedding vows at Cana, and even sail on the Sea of Galilee. At every step of the way, we will deepen our knowledge of Scripture and Tradition as we listen to our professional guides, and read the scriptures associated with each site. Each day, we will have the chance to enjoy sumptuous buffet breakfasts and dinners, and spend restful evenings in first class hotels in Bethlehem, Tiberius, and Jerusalem.

All-Inclusive pricing starts at \$3,196 from New York (\$3,394 from Washington-Dulles Airport). Optional extensions in Jerusalem, and to Egypt and Jordan are also available.
