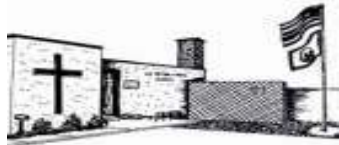


## SCHOOL NEWS.... 3rd/4th Grade: Mrs. Riner
